AGE CRITERION

Age of the candidate as recorded in the Birth Certificate issued by the Civil Authority, will determine the eligibility for admission to a particular class.

S.No	Class	Criterion
1.	Class I	As on 31 st of March : 6 years (Child born on 1 st of April will also be considered)
2.	Class II onwards	As per Transfer Certificate (From a recognized School)

FEE RULES/ADMISSION CRITERIA

- For all the students, fee is payable in three equal installments i.e. in the months of **April, September** and **December** by the **5th** of the relevant month. The amount deposited towards registration, admission, caution and any other fee will neither be refunded nor transferred to any other year or towards sibling's fee.
- Advance fee for the whole year, may be deposited in the beginning of the session. Term fee, annual fee, examination fee and development charges will automatically be linked with the rise in the **price index/operational cost** and may be increased by about **10-20%** at the beginning of the subsequent session as determined by the school's board of Management.
- After 10th of the due month, fees will be accepted with late fee @ USD 5 per day. No fee will be accepted after **15th** of the due month and the name of the student will be struck off the rolls. For re-admission, **USD300** will be charged.
- No student whose fee remains unpaid either in full or in part will be allowed to sit for the school based/board based examinations.
- Internal examination results, Transfer certificate, Report card and Recommendation letters to other schools/colleges will not be issued to the student or parent unless outstanding dues are cleared.
- It is mandatory for all the students (class II onwards) to submit the Transfer Certificate from the last school attended. No student will be admitted to the school without the submission of an official Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended. Nor will the student be placed in the class higher than that for which the Transfer Certificate shows him/her to be qualified.

WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

1. One term's notice must be given to the school before withdrawing a student or pay one term's fees in lieu of notice.
2. Transfer Certificate will not be issued unless all dues are settled. It is mandatory to produce original fee receipt while claiming Caution Deposit.
3. Parents willing to withdraw their ward at the end of the session need to give one term prior written notice to the school (on or before 15th Dec) else one term fee shall be charged.

DECLARATION

The admission to IPS is provisional and will be regularized only on production of the original mark sheet and Transfer Certificate from the previous school.
