A total of Fifteen (15) water closets, 7 wash hand basins have been provided to cater for the school population.

WATER SUPPLY

The premise is supplied with portable water from Nairobi Water and Sewerage Company. The water is also purified with the use of Reverse Osmosis (RO) technology to ensure safety.

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT
